

ClearScript Partial Fill Program

The ClearScript Partial Fill Program helps control the cost of expensive specialty medications while promoting better health outcomes.

Patients who begin treatment with oral specialty medications may discontinue or change medications in the first weeks of therapy. This often results in waste of expensive, unused medication and comes at a high cost to plan sponsors. The ClearScript Partial Fill Program facilitates patient monitoring to prevent waste of these medications, help control specialty pharmacy costs, and promote better health outcomes.

How the ClearScript Partial Fill Program Works

The ClearScript Partial Fill Program uses plan designs to limit the first six fills of selected oral specialty medications to a maximum 15 day supply. Members are able to try the medication and be monitored for adherence and adverse effects before a full 30 day maximum supply is dispensed. Unnecessary drug waste is avoided when therapy is discontinued or changed. Because these drugs are so expensive, eliminating waste of just a few days supply can result in significant cost savings to plan sponsors.

Program Flexibility

The ClearScript Partial Fill Program offers flexibility to plan sponsors regarding their specialty pharmacy providers.

- As our partner, Fairview Specialty Pharmacy offers personalized adherence monitoring and counseling throughout therapy.
- Plan sponsors designating a different specialty pharmacy can implement the program as a plan design feature to help control specialty costs.

Example of Savings

The ingredient cost of a 28 day supply of the hepatitis C drug Harvoni[®] is approximately \$31,500. If a member stops taking this medication within the first two weeks of treatment, more than half of the medication may go unused. By limiting the first fill to a 14 day supply, the cost savings may be in excess of \$15,750 simply by avoiding waste of this expensive medication.
