II. Principal's Update (Barb)

- a. Presentation on sponsorships of Lakefront Days (the Prior Lake mayor is very into the Rotary, which helps put on the event)
 - i. ½ of every ticket sold in RR's name goes to the PTC.
 - ii. With the several levels of sponsorship, any one secured in RR's name, we get half of that, too.

- a. Planning session of the PTC Board (looking ahead mostly to 2017-2018)
 - i. Open/more frequent communication with parents and teachers (beyond the minutes), social media campaigns, expanded PTC welcome guide each year
 - ii. Fund and arrange school-wide presenters (1 this spring, 3 next year) Barb mentioned that she received information from Kat Perkins' publicist for us to explore
 - iii. Provide annual teacher and grade level funding
 - iv. Fundraising with focused recipient groups or school items, like 2 large events (Family Fun Night, Read-A-Thon), monthly dinners, care fund and other
 - v. Box Tops and Tyson labels – **Vanessa Muir volunteered to research this**
- b. Discontinuation of School Store – No more gift cards and no more reminders (gift cards still remaining may be used)

IV. Treasurer's Update (Angela)

- a. Balance (\$25K ChipShoppe invoice not paid): \$38,590.36
- b. Balance for DOGS: \$2,228.51
- c. \$295 will be put toward the Read-A-Thon cookie party (for reaching the \$10K benchmark) on Friday, Feb. 10. 65 dozen cookies for students and a few big cookies for the staff lounge.

- a. February Read-A-Thon
 - i. As of the meeting, \$19,609 raised so far 10 days in!
 - ii. Mrs. Haugh's class was the first to reach the class goal of \$1,300. She gets coffee for a week!
