School Board will study K-5 attendance boundary change recommendations Monday

After months of planning, the School Board will formally review recommendations on K-5 attendance boundary changes on Monday. Map options B1 and C1 have been forwarded for Board consideration. The boundary proposals can be viewed [here](#).

The Board meeting will take place on Monday, April 22 at 6 p.m. at the District Services Center, 4540 Tower Street SE, Prior Lake. There will be an opportunity for public comment at the end of the meeting for those who wish to address the Board regarding any topic on the agenda.

Next steps

After the Board studies the recommendations and listens to public comment April 22, the Board will hold a study session on May 6 at 5:30 p.m., directly before its regular board meeting, to further discuss the boundary changes and next steps to take action on elementary boundary changes.

Attendance boundary background information

K-5 attendance boundaries are being redrawn for the 2020/21 school year to ensure we have adequate instructional and co-curricular space throughout our district for our growing student population. New elementary attendance boundaries will help even out enrollment across the district as we open our new school, Hamilton Ridge Elementary. Our goal is to maintain K-5 attendance boundaries for five years, given consistent growth patterns and housing development.

Some additional details to note:

- While we will maintain similar K-5 school start times, specific elementary school start-times for 2020-21 will also be reviewed in an effort to gain efficiencies with transportation.
- La ola del lago Spanish immersion school will be a district K-5 school, located at Grainwood Elementary, beginning in the fall of 2020.
- Edgewood School will continue to be home to Pre-K programs.
- 2019/20 In-district Transfer (IDT) protocol is unchanged from this current year. We will communicate to families in the fall of 2019 IDT protocols for the 2020/21 school year.
- After In-district Transfer placements have been made, open enrollment placements will be made.
