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## **SAVE THE DATE! IMPORTANT SCHEDULING INFORMATION FOR YOUR CHILD!**

On August 6th, 7th & 8th we will be offering the “Great Start to Kindergarten” experience for incoming Kindergarten students. A trained staff member will work with each child one-on-one to measure reading, math and social skills. The testing will take up to 30 minutes and will help us place your child in the kindergarten classroom that is best suited for him/her. Further information will be sent to Kindergarten parents regarding sign-up of the assessments.

On September 4th and 5th, all students in grades 1-5 will meet with their 2018-19 teacher individually for approximately 30 minutes for literacy assessments. The assessment results will give teachers the data they need to target instruction for students from the first day of the school year. You will receive communication in mid- August that will include information on how to sign-up for an assessment.

**The first official day of classes for students in grades K- 5 is September 6th.**

## **TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS**

Teacher assignments and beginning of the year information will be mailed mid-August. Please be sure the Main Office has been notified if you have had any change of mailing address information.

A bag lunch will be served to students on that day. **All students will be dismissed at 12:50 p.m.** Please make plans accordingly. We request that all students follow their normal routine home as usual on this busy day. We want to make sure that children get home safely.

## **END OF THE YEAR MEDICATION PICKUP**

Medications including rescue medications (Inhalers, Epi-Pens, etc.) **cannot** be sent home with elementary school students. We recommend leaving rescue medication at school until dismissal of the last day. Please pick up all medications no later than June 7th (by dismissal time at 12:50). The District is unable to store medication over the summer; **medication remaining in the health office will be properly disposed of after the last day of school.** Please call your school's Health Office, 952-226-8006, if you wish to make other arrangements.

### **IMPORTANT: 2018-19 Health Forms**

Health Services will no longer mail copies of the Annual Health and the Emergency Contact forms. Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, we will move to an electronic delivery of these forms.

**Please print the Annual Verification of Health (linked below) and any other forms if needed (linked below). Complete and return to school prior to the start of the new school year.** If you do not have printer access, please contact our secretary at 952-226-8000.

#### **Annual Verification of Health:**

- 2018-2019 [Annual Verification of Health](#) is available online. Please fill this out and return to your student's school to ensure a complete health and safety plan for your student.

**Medications:** All prescription and over-the-counter medications, supplements, lotions, etc. require a current physician's order at the beginning of each school year.

- [Medication Authorization Form](#): Please have your physician fill out and sign page 1. Page 2 must be signed by the parent/guardian.
- Medication will only be accepted in a current, original, and fully labeled bottle.

#### **Emergency Action Plans are required at school for the following:**

WHAT: Immunizations for Uninsured or Underinsured Children Entering School or Childcare:

DTap, Td or Tdap, Polio, MMR, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Varicella, PCV 13, Hib, Gardasil and Menactra

Children eligible for the vaccine include those on Medical Assistance MA, Minnesota Care, anyone younger than 19 without insurance, children with insurance but with out-of-pocket expenses for the vaccination, and immigrants and refugees. If your child has MA or is on PMAP, please bring their card.

Please bring your child's previous immunization record. A \$10 donation per shot is appreciated to cover administrative costs. Call **952-496-8552** for appointment or questions.
